Entries close JULY 16, 2011

1. Entries due: JULY 16, 2011 by 12:00 PM. Entry fee: \$5.00 per head/per class.
2. Send entries to: Menard County Fair, 18450 Fairgrounds St., P.O. Box 375, Petersburg, IL 62675.
3. The base date is JULY 23, 2011, which is the date the animal is to be judged.
4. Exhibitors must be the registered owners and make entry in the exact names (owner and animal) as shown on the registration certificate. For all animals 18 months of age or over photocopies of registration papers must be sent with the entry form for verification of name and age. Failure to meet this requirement prohibits entry in the show.
5. Health papers are not required. To the best of the owners' knowledge, the llama must be healthy and appear in good condition. Llamas must show no sign of infectious or contagious disease; all vaccinations and worming must be current. Please refer to the health requirement information found in back of this book.
6. Animals may arrive after 4:00 P.M. on FRIDAY, JULY 22, 2011. Animals must be in place by 7:00 A.M. SATURDAY, JULY 23, 2011. They will be released immediately following the show.
7. Judging will begin at 8:00 AM on JULY 23, 2011.
8. Each exhibitor must comply with the general Menard County Fair Livestock Rules. Please refer to these.
9. Anyone whose name is on the registration paper must have an EXHIBITOR'S TICKET.
10. Checks will be issued one week after the fair is completed.
11. Exhibitors must wear their exhibitor number card into the ring on the front of their body or they will not be allowed to show.
12. Showmanship classes have no entry fee and no premiums are paid.
13. Only two entries per class.
14. All llamas must be shown in their appropriate halter class. Llamas entered in the wrong wool division can be moved by the judge.
15. The same Llama can not be shown in both the Jr. and Sr. classes.
16. No one under 12 years of age can show an adult intact male.
17. Unruly animals may be dismissed from the ring and unsportsmanlike behavior will not be tolerated.
18. All Exhibitors must purchase an exhibitor's ticket.
