1. Entries in this department are open to the world.
2. Exhibits must be placed between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. on Monday, July 19, 2010 OR between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, July 20, 2010. Exhibitors are asked to pick up premium checks and exhibits BETWEEN 4:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. the last day of the Fair, SUNDAY, JULY 25, 2010. If you can not pick up your exhibits at the stated time, please make arrangements with the superintendent at the time you bring your entries to the textiles building. NO CHECKS WILL BE ISSUED FROM THE OFFICE.
3. NO VISITORS ARE ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING DURING JUDGING.
4. Entries must have been completed BY THE EXHIBITOR within the last TWO years and NOT been previously exhibited at the Menard County Fair. If the same pattern is used be sure that you use an obviously different colored yarn, fabric, thread, etc. Records are being kept and judges have the right to disqualify any item they have judged before.
5. No baskets. No jewelry.
6. Exhibitors are limited to ONE entry per class.
7. NO ENTRY FEES WILL BE RETURNED.
8. All needlework will be judged on the difficulty of the work and the degree of perfection in execution, the suitability for the purpose which it was intended and the over-all appearance. Pressing, finishing, framing, etc., are critical in the over-all look of the finished piece.
9. Entry tags must be sewn or affixed with a safety pin to each article. All garments must be displayed on hangers in clear plastic bags, entry tags must be sewn or safety pinned to the left sleeve or left armhole.
10. Exhibits that have been erroneously entered may, at the discretion of the judges, be transferred to or from the class entered and placed in the proper class prior to judging. If such classes have been judged, they shall not be re-opened, and will be ineligible and late entries will be disqualified. Exhibitors must bring own exhibits.
11. Failure to follow the above rules could cause disqualification.
12. All Exhibitors must purchase an exhibitor's ticket.
